what's for **SUPPER?**

1. BUILD A FIRE.

Build a fire in a safe location away from trees above and grass below, and in a designated spot if possible.

2. THE RIGHT EQUIPMENT.

Remember that plastic melts in the fire! See the checklist to make sure you have everything you need for cooking success!

3. COOKING METHOD.

From old-fashioned skewer cooking, tinfoil wrapped and placed on the coals, or using a grill meant for the fire, there are many ways to safely prepare your meals.

BANNOCK

- 2-3 cups of flour
- 1-2 Tbsp baking powder
- 2-3 Tbsp butter
- 2/3 cup warm water
 Mix all ingredients in a bowl, slowly
 adding the water last. Knead until soft
 dough forms. Wrap a small handful
 around a stick and cook evenly by
 rotating.

CAMPERS' STEW

- Crumbled hamburger,
- Chopped potatoes, Onions, Carrots, Broccoli, Mushrooms, Peppers
- 1 Tbsp of Butter
- Seasonings
- Mix the ingredients and wrap them up tight in 15" strips of tinfoil, laying them in the coals until the veggies are soft. Enjoy your simple, mess-free dinner!

4. LET YOUR KIDS HELP.

Build children's confidence around the fire by designating them tasks to accomplish. Don't forget to make rules that keep them safe, such as, "once it's in the fire, it does not come out."

5. PUT OUT, CLEAN UP & SECURE THE SITE.

Don't forget to thoroughly drench your fire, stir, and douse until the coals are cold to avoid forest fires. Clean up the site and secure it well so animals are not attracted to the food smells and the garbage. This can be harmful to both the people and the animals.

FIRED POTATOES

- Large baking potatoes, Thinly sliced onions, Dill, parsley, bacon bits
- Slice the potatoes thinly, almost all the way through. Wedge the onion slices in each of the potato slits, then season, wrap in tinfoil, and put in the fire for 45 minutes, or until soft. Count your potatoes so you don't lose them in the fire!

KEBABS

- Cubed beef or pork, Chopped onions, mushrooms, and peppers
- slip ingredients onto the skewers alternating flavors. Cook over open fire until done.

CHOCO-NANA

- Cut a banana lengthwise, sprinkle
- chocolate all over the flesh.
- Wrap it up in tinfoil and put it in the coals for 10 minutes. Enjoy your campfire dessert!
