Geocaching is a real world outdoor treasure hunting game that uses GPS enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache container hidden at that location.

After you locate the geocache the "rules" are simple: if you remove something from the cache, leave something of equal or greater value, write about your find in the cache logbook, and log your experience at geocaching.com.


### START GEOCACHING TODAY! HERE'S HOW TO GET STARTED:

## Walking Trails

Spend a relaxing afternoon walking and soaking up the natural beauty and fresh air of the Frontier!

### **FOOTNER WALKING TRAILS**

Enjoy beautiful trails marked with interpretative signage along the way. This is a perfect location for bird watching and enjoying panoramic views of Footner Lake. You may even catch sight of a water bomber scooping water off the lake!



### LA CRETE WALKING TRAILS

With 3 kilometers of trails just north of town and 900 meters in town, the La Crete walking trails are a great way to spend a warm summer evening. Bike, rollerblade, or stroll through a beautiful forest that ends with a spectacular view of Tourangeau Lake.

### FORT VERMILION RIVER WALK

Stroll along scenic trails right beside the Peace River. Pick up Mackenzie Frontier's "Fort Vermilion Historical Guide" and revel in a walking tour of one of the oldest settlements of Alberta. Look out for interpretative signage of historical buildings and stop by the viewing deck to enjoy an ice cream!
