

Fishing



Access the **Peace River** at Tompkins Landing or Fort Vermilion and fish for pike, walleye, gold eye, whitefish or trout.

The **Ponton River** offers arctic grayling.

Machesis Lake has stocked rainbow trout, and it features two docks, a fish cleaning station and a cook shelter.

Wadlin Lake and **Hutch Lake** are popular for northern pike and pickerel.

You'll also find stocked fish ponds in the **Zama City Campground & Park**, **Jimmy's Pond** in Fort Vermilion and **Twin Ponds** in Bluehills.

Trails and Hiking

Footner Lake Trails is a perfect stop for families, hikers and adventurers. With hiking trails through a beautiful treed area along Footner Lake, this is a place to enjoy the outdoors, bird watching and feeding as well as a place to enjoy a picnic lakeside.

Enjoy the **River Walk along River Road in Fort Vermilion**. The serene walking trails offer beautiful views overlooking the Peace River.

Located 35 km SE of La Crete, **Buffalo Head Lookout** offers incredible views and beautiful picnic spots. Bring binoculars and a camera to explore the scenery, and be sure to check out the geocache!

Jubilee Park in La Crete is located on 100 St. and offers walking paths, a pond, a skate park, a shelter, volleyball, swings, and fire pits. Jubilee is also home to the Summer Farmers Market on Wednesdays!



Bike, roller blade or stroll along the paved **La Crete Walking Trails**, with 3.1 km of trails just outside of town and 900 m in town, or 3 km trail on the northwest side of town taking you through a beautiful forest that ends with a spectacular view of Tourangeau Lake.

The **Town of High Level Walking Trails** offer a

variety of open and treed areas perfect for walking, running and biking.

Enjoy the scenery and solitude of the **Rocky Lane Ag Society Recreational Trails** with paths through the valley that allow hiking and horseback riding in the summer.
